



Zev Feldman is a competitive skier, so running down a mountain is second nature. But running his lines for a school musical production? Terrifying.

Now a junior at Green Mountain Valley School, a prep school for skiers in Waitsfield, Feldman was shaking with nerves the first time he rehearsed a solo for last year's production of "Newsies." He worried that a school full of jocks might mock his involvement in an artistic production.

He thought his solo was not good, but the immediate support he got from his cast mates was so positive it took all the pressure off. His stage fright was gone.

"My heart wasn't even, like, beating fast," Feldman said. "I was just really happy to be doing what I was doing."







#### A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

When I first set foot on this campus, I was immediately struck by its pristine beauty. An academic sanctuary nestled in the Green Mountains of my home state—shortly thereafter, I was struck by a soccer ball in the head. Both left a resounding impression, and both keep me coming back. The beauty and the unexpected.

When I first took this position in 2021, I assumed it would be a one-off. A perfect segue back into theatre after the pandemic brought my acting career to a screeching halt. What I didn't realize is that this school and its students would help me grow my craft as a theatre artist. Like the Hammerstein lyric I've known my whole life but only now understand its meaning: "It's a very ancient saying, but a true and honest thought, that when you become a teacher by your pupils you'll be taught." Seeing these young skiers learn who they are by jumping head first into something that scares them is inspirational. It gives me hope for the future and the will to keep sharing my passion with the world around me.

After our recent modern day musical productions: *Mamma Mia!* and *Newsies*, Ashley O'Brien and I wanted to tackle a classic piece from the American musical theatre cannon. *Damn Yankees* is a celebration of baseball, team spirit, and the heart required to pursue your passion. Win or lose, at the end of the day we're all better for having played. In the 1950s, we were a nation still reeling from WWII and in need of a reminder about who we wanted to be. Created by Broadway legends, and based on a novel by Douglass Wallop, this 1955 musical is chalk-full of fiction, unlikely characters, and goofy dance numbers—intentionally giving its audience an opportunity to escape our sometimes troubling reality and enjoy the joy we create to survive.

We invite you all to do just that, sit back, relax, open your hearts, and enjoy the game.


