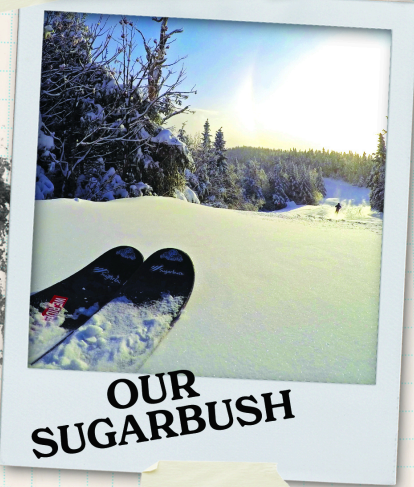

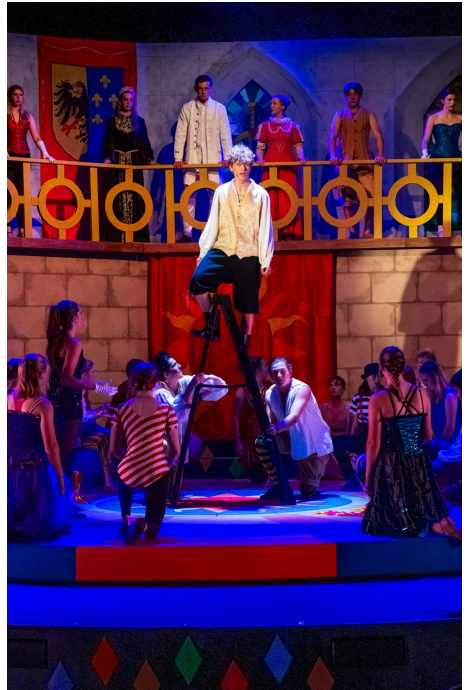
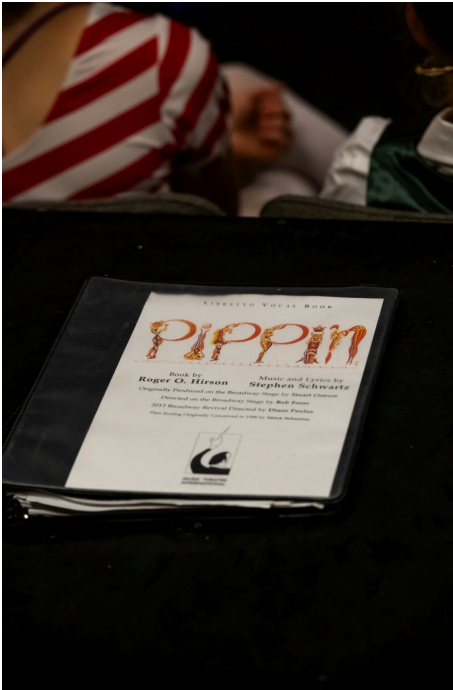

DRAMATURGY CORNER

WHO WAS CHARLEMAGNE?

This fall, the GMVS French 5 class, taught by Jen Robillard, studied Charlemagne. Based on the research of their French 5 class, Hadley Reed '26 and Paige Fieldhouse PG '24, provide a bit of context for Pippin's story below.

Charlemagne (748-814 AD) was a significant figure in early European history. He was king of the Franks, the founder of the Holy Roman Empire and is known to have been a powerful advocate for education. Charlemagne expanded his kingdom from a portion of current France into all of France and what is now Germany, Switzerland, Italy and Austria. He was crowned king of the Holy Roman Empire after defending the pope from rebellion. Both Charlemagne's father, Pippin the Short (Pépin le Bref) and two of Charlemagne's sons were named Pippin. Charlemagne's first son, Pippin the Hunchback (Pépin le Bossu) was involved in a failed assassination attempt against his father, but was pardoned and later became a monk. His brother Carleman was named king of Italy by his father when he was only two years old. He was later baptized Pippin of Italy (Pépin d'Italie). Another one of Charlemagne's sons was named Louis (known as Lewis in the musical) and was a devout member of the church. Charlemagne's mother, Berthe (Bertrada de Laon) was said to have a big influence on his early reign. Fastrada was Charlemagne's third wife.

DISCLAIMER:

Please note, Pippin boldly and intentionally departs from history in almost every way except a few choice names. Although, who knows? Perhaps Pippin could, in fact, juggle.



DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Pippin is the story of a young person's pursuit of living an extraordinary life. Here at GMVS, that's what we're all about. We go for gold. Each person's journey toward extraordinary looks different. For me, it has been an unexpected one. I came to campus back in 2021, during a pandemic hiatus from my pursuit of Broadway. I was excited by the challenge of engaging young athletes in a creative undertaking. I assumed it would be a one-off but was determined to make it count for a community that was denied their annual musical in 2020. We brought Donna's Grecian taverna to life, and in doing so, revived GMVS Theater with a disco fever. I met a school community hungry for art, willing and talented athletes turned actors, and a team of rockstar designers/builders who brought excellence to their work. I was hooked.

Since *Mamma Mia!*, our theater program has grown each year. *Newsies* allowed us to seize the day. *Damn Yankees* helped us find heart. And with *Pippin* we're hoping to make magic. It challenges both its players and audience to co-create a magical world where severed heads can talk, old grandma's can fly, and circus arts are the chosen vernacular. The circus is the ideal setting for *Pippin* because it's the very place where people come to see extraordinary things. Four years later, I am proud to say, the same is true of GMVS Theater.


Pippin is based on a historical figure from the Middle Ages, a dark and dreary time in Europe when war was rampant. Castles were built like fortresses with weathered stone and wood.
